School Rules Reminder

*Please can I remind parents that fees are due on the 1st class of each 1/2 term. Please come see me before we start your child's class, so that the time used comes from your own child's class, not the from next group. If all payments are received together, then less time overall will be used up, and therefore more time for Dancing!

Your invoices have a remittance slip at the bottom which you can tear off and stick into an envelope or paperclip together with your payment.

If you miss the last class of the 1/2 term, then you will not have received your invoice. Please contact me before the first class back if you would like to know how much will be due, or at least bring some form of payment with you.

*Please do not enter the studio whilst the music is playing, and children are dancing. I'm sure you are aware of how easily children can be distracted and the 1 second look at the door can lose their focus to the point where we have to stop the music and start again!

*Hair should always be worn off the face wherever possible. I do not require hair in a slick bun or anything fancy, a simple pony tail is fab, or for short hair an Alice band or a few clips is fine.

*Can you ensure that pupils have the opportunity of going to the toilet before their class. Not only have you paid for their lesson time but leaving the room for just a couple minutes is quite detrimental for the direction of thought, and valuable teaching points will be missed.

*Please can you notify me in advance if your child will be leaving the school. If you do not BEFORE the last week of 1/2 term, then your next invoice will have been written, and therefore will become due even if I do not see the child again.

If pupils miss 3 or more lessons in a row and I have not been informed then I will assume the child is no longer attending and that place may be assigned to another pupil. Although I will not answer my phone whilst teaching, I am fairly easy to contact, and you could always leave me a message.
